

House in the Historic Center of Cascais

Located at the historical centre of Cascais, this project was supplied with 3 different materials for 2 bathrooms and 1 kitchen. For the common bathroom, the children's one, the choice was to the **Pinta Verde** marble, polished finishing. Of a clear and clean background and an unique joyfull green veining, this marble covers the floor and some of the bathroom's walls creating also an apparently solid vanity-top that resulted in a beautiful and successful piece.

At the social bathroom, the client opted to simply pave and skirt the area in natural stone. The **Zimbabwe** black granite was chosen, with its intense black colour, and then combined with colourful and joyfully painted walls.

For the kitchen the selection was to **Arcadia**, of our Quartz Compound Collection. An excellent resistance and a neutral and homogeneous white tone to combine with colored painted walls.
